

Conakry, Guinea, July 11 (Infosplusgabon) - Liberian President, George Weah, is expected in Conakry, Guinea, on Thursday for a 48-hour working visit, officials said on Wednesday.

Elected in 2018 as head of his country, President Weah, who will make his first visit to Guinea, will be accompanied by several ministers and experts from Liberia.

Weah and his host, Alpha Condé, will take advantage of their meeting to discuss several issues of the Mano River Union to which both countries, Côte d'Ivoire and Sierra Leone are members.

The two statesmen will discuss security issues in the sub-region, and the feasibility of signing maritime and energy agreements between Guinea and Liberia.
