

Cotonou, Benin, September 17 (Infosplusgabon) - Some 87 directors of the General Education College have been relieved of their duties, for shortcomings in the examinations of the past academic year, according to a decree of the Minister of Secondary, Technical Education and Professional Training, published on Friday.

According to the decree obtained on Monday, the directors concerned were relieved of their duties due to insufficient results in examinations for the 2018-2019 academic year, in particular the first cycle degree (Bepc) and the bachelor. The same decree places the involved persons in the position of deputy during two school years.

The directors concerned are spread over eleven (11) of the twelve (12) departments of the country as follows: 12 in the department of Alibori, 9 in Atacora; 3 in the Atlantic; 2 in the Borgou; 24 in the Hills; 6 in the Couffo; 8 in the Donga; 8 in the Mono; 3 in Oueme; 4 in the Plateau and 8 in the Zou.
