

Tripoli, Libya, January 29 (Infosplusgabon) - Malek al-Ghaziwi, a child injured when the Hadhbat al-Badri area, southeast of Tripoli, was shelled on, has become the fourth child to die in the bombing, according to the Center for Medicine and Field Support on Wednesday.

A third child died on Tuesday night of his injuries, while early reports indicated that two children killed and two others seriously injured in the attack by Haftar forces.

The ages of the victims ranged from 9 to 12 years old.

The military operation, "Volcano of Anger", under the government of national accord announced on Tuesday that "a random shell landed in the courtyard behind a school in the Hadhbat al-Badri area."

Libyan National Army forces violated the ceasefire on Tuesday with a drone that was shot down Tuesday by government forces east of Misrata (220 km east of Tripoli).
