

Tunis Tunisia, April 4 (Infosplusgabon) - Tunisia's Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Slim Chora on Friday stressed the need for international intervention to find a solution to the difficult situation faced by African students in Tunisia, which is going through exceptional moment due to the spread of coronavirus (Covid-19) in the country.
