

KIGALI, Rwanda, September 12 (Infosplusgabon) - Malian striker Ismaila Diarra, 25, is set to sign another contract with Rwanda's first division side, Rayon Sports, for the upcoming season, Sports sources confirmed Tuesday in Kigali.

Diarra is the second Malian player to join Rayon Sports after his compatriot Moussa Camara, 23, who arrived at Rayon Sports in 2016 for a contract that is expected to end by the 2017/18 season.

Before joining Rayon Sports in late 2016, Diarra played for Malian Premier League Division side "Cercle Olympique Bamako".

More recently, he played for the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) first division club, Daring Club Motema Pembe.

Commenting on the latest move, Rayon Sports head Coach, Olivier Karekezi, noted that the Rwandan club is convinced that Diarra will find here all the conditions to fully express his talent.

"At 25 years, he is a great player who is mature," Karekezi said.

Rayon Sports is the 2016/2017 Champions in the Rwanda Premier League.
